

## Classroom Assessment Research Team Knowledge Mobilization Project

Opportunity: Knowledge Mobilization Coordinator (limited-term part-time position/project-based position)

Located within the Faculty of Education at Queen's University and led by Christopher DeLuca, the Classroom Assessment Research Team (CART) works to rethink classroom assessment theory and practice through leading empirical scholarship. CART explores the complexities of educational assessment in schools across several nationally funded projects and in partnership with colleagues from around the world. CART's research has been published in top-quality Canadian and international journals including Assessment in Education, Educational Assessment, Teaching and Teacher Education, Teachers College Record, and Journal of Teacher Education.

## **Knowledge Mobilization Project**

CART aims to disseminate its research through a diverse yet targeted knowledge mobilization (KMb) approach. As part of our KMb Project, we are seeking a KMb Coordinator for a limited-term, part-time position to develop and enact a comprehensive KMb plan. Specific tasks involved with this plan will include:

- Developing 1-minute engaging video abstracts for key CART projects (10 videos total: videos to include still images and text drawn from articles/project descriptions)
- Developing branded abstracts for academic and practitioner articles produced by CART
- Developing branded infographics for all academic and practitioner articles produced by CART (approximately 30 infographics total)
- Updating and editing CART websites on the WIX interface (i.e., updating latest articles, uploading infographics, link to articles, uploading branded abstracts)
- Establishing social media dissemination plan and platform for regular mobilization of infographics and article abstracts (e.g., HootSuite)
- Updating and editing Curriculum Vitae of CART leadership
