- Build, advance, and apply robust evidence in priority areas.





Structures in Place


- Network goals/objectives are similar to current government


KNAER aims to develop applied education research networks, KMb and research use capacity, and evidence-informed education practices to support the renewed priorities of Achieving Excellence.




Vision for Thematic Networks






PIC

- ✓ KMb capacity building and connecting research and practice for evidence-informed education






Evaluator

- ✓ offer a final summative evaluation




